Each participating state selects one design that represents their state and the creative spirit of YAM. Also, we are excited to announce that NAEA has invited the Council to show off the 2009 YAM flags during the opening, general session of its convention this year. The flags will be marched in a procession onto the stage where they will remain throughout the opening session. At the conclusion of the session, the flags will be carried back to "open" the exhibit area before they are put on display in the YAM Museum! We are hopeful that all 50 states will be able to participate in the flag event this year; and we thank NAEA for their support of National Youth Art Month!
